500g Mixed Fruit
125g Butter
1 cup Sugar
¾ cup Water
1 tsp Spice
1 tsp Bicarb Soda
1 tsp Baking Powder
2 eggs, beaten
125g Cornflour
1 1/3 cups Soya Flour

Combine the first 5 ingredients in a saucepan, bring to the boil and cook for 10 minutes. Cool, then stir in soda and baking powder. Stir in the eggs, then cornflour and soy flour. Put in 20cm prepared tin. Bake in moderate oven for 60-70 minutes or until cooked.

*** For a richer cake add ¼ cup Brandy or Rum.
