Hints from the Judge

- Read your schedule carefully
- All bottles to be clean
- No commercial printing (cover with contact or similar)
- No measurements etc to be marked in glass
- All lids to be clean
- No rust or dirt on inside of lid
- No jam/jelly/pickles to be on inside of lid
- No cloth covers on lids
- Do not use wax in bottles
- Bottle to be filled to neck – do not overfill or under fill
- Bottle to be cleaned around inside of neck
- Pickles should be thickened
- Jam containing lumps of fruit is really a conserve
- Collections of jams/jellies etc should have the same size bottles.
