Rules and Regulations

Entries close **Wednesday 16 November** Entries to be made on the Cattle Entry Form provided and addressed to the Beef Cattle Section, PO Box 153, Dorrigo NSW 2453.

1. Admittance into the judging ring only permitted with proof of payment of showground entrance or membership fee, and Indemnity form signed. i.e. **Wristband Must Be Worn**. This will be strictly enforced.
3. Age of cattle to be taken on and inclusive of 1 November.
4. Handlers must be over 5 years and under 25 years on and inclusive of 1 November.
5. Exhibits must be registered or eligible for registration with their respective Breed Society.
6. All exhibits to be led for judging.
7. Exhibitors to provide own bedding and hoses. Initial sawdust may be available.
8. Committee reserves the right to combine classes.
9. Current Johnes Disease Declaration forms to accompany entries.
10. Please ensure entries have their NLIS tag, exhibitors responsibility to make sure their cattle have been scanned in and out. Please have your PIC with you.

Rules and Regulations

Entries close **Wednesday 16 November**. Entries to be made on the Cattle Entry Form provided and addressed to the Beef Cattle Section, PO Box 153, Dorrigo NSW 2453.

1. Entry fees must be paid at time of entry and accompanied by Certificate of Currency for Public Liability \$5 million. No phone entries will be accepted.
2. Admittance into the judging ring only permitted with proof of payment of showground entrance or membership fee, and signed indemnity form i.e. **Wristband Must Be Worn**. This will be strictly enforced.
3. Age of cattle to be taken on and inclusive of 1 November.
4. Exhibits must be registered or eligible for registration with their respective Breed Society.
5. All exhibits to be led for judging.
6. **NO BEDDING STRAW ALLOWED**. Sawdust will be provided.
7. Stewards reserve the right to combine classes.
8. Stewards reserve the right to have any animal removed from the judging ring, main arena or other areas, if in their opinion, such animal is classed as dangerous, intractable or is disadvantaging other exhibits.
9. The judge will not be bound to grant an award where there is insufficient merit.
10. Calves may be paraded with their mothers provided cow is lactating and calf is under 8 months.
11. All persons leading exhibits in judging ring must wear dust coats or applicable uniforms.
12. Junior champion to be taken from under 20 months.
13. Current Johnes Disease Declaration form to accompany entries.
14. Bulls over 12 mths must have nose rings. All females and bulls under 12 months must have nose ring or have nose-grips in single classes.
15. Neck straps or chains are compulsory on all animals over 8 months when not in the control of an attendant.
16. All animals being paraded on the showground must have halters and nose lead attached at all times.
17. All cattle entered must remain on the grounds until after the grand parade and all prize winning cattle must take part in the grand parade at approximately 2:00 pm.
18. All cattle will be inspected and scanned on grounds. It is the exhibitors responsibility to make sure their cattle have been scanned in and out. Please have your PIC with you.
